Throughout the course, we will focus on the following key topics: a) Understanding and addressing the significant challenges faced by 21st-century cities. b) Examining the territories of social vulnerability in Latin America and exploring the strategies and actions taken to address the rapid expansion of informal settlements. c) Studying the concept of social urbanism and its implications in urban planning and development. This will be achieved through readings and theoretical lectures that offer a comprehensive understanding of such complex urban spaces. - Social Urbanism: We will delve into the concept of social urbanism, understanding its principles and applications in urban planning and development.
