The Intern will work as part of the project team to assist in the origination, due diligence, structuring, negotiation and bidding of infrastructure projects.

Main assignments

- Support Infrastructure PPP Advisory Department activities;
- Prepare presentations for current and potential governmental clients, with guidance from the Investment Officer;
- Gather required information to support the elaboration of documents;
- Prepare internal reports using official data, sector reports and other sources, with guidance from the Investment Officer;
